Army Tuition Assistance (TA)

- ◇ The student is the one who applies for the benefit through the GoArmyEd portal or with the help of an Army Education specialist.
- ◇ TA will not approve aid after the beginning of the academic term.

Chapter 1606 Montgomery GI Bill® Selected Reserve

- ◇ For Reservists with a six-year obligation in the Selected Reserve who are actively drilling.
- ◇ Members of the Reserve or National Guard
- ◇ Complete your initial active duty for training (IADT).
- ◇ Basic monthly allowance
- ◇ Benefit **DOES NOT** pay tuition

Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill® Active Duty

- ◇ For active duty members who enroll and pay \$100 per month for 12 months and are then entitled to receive a monthly education benefit once they have completed a minimum service obligation.
- ◇ Benefit **DOES NOT** pay tuition
- ◇ To receive payments you must confirm your attendance to the courses on the last day of each month through the WAVE system or by phone at 1 (877) 823-2378.

Capítulo 35—DEA DEPENDENDANTS AND SURVIVORS

- ◇ If you're the child or spouse of a Veteran or service member who has died, is captured or missing, or has disabilities, you may be able to get help paying for school or job training through the DEA program
- ◇ If you're the child of a Veteran or service member you can get benefits if you're between the ages of 18 and 26, except in certain cases. You may be married or unmarried.
- ◇ If you began using this program to pay for your school or training before August 1, 2018, you can get benefits for up to 45 months.
- ◇ If you began using the program on or after August 1, 2018, you can get benefits for up to 36 months.
- ◇ Monthly payment

Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill®

- ◇ Calls to service under Title 10 after September 10, 2001 and have completed 90 days or more.
- ◇ The Post-9/11 GI Bill® provides up to 36 months of education benefits.
- ◇ If your release from active duty was before January 1, 2013 there is a 15-year time limitation for use of benefits. For individuals whose last discharge date is on or after January 1, 2013 the time limitation has been removed.
- ◇ Pay tuition costs directly to the Institution, according to the percentage of eligibility (40% - 100%)
- ◇ Monthly housing allowance
- ◇ Annual books and supplies stipend
- ◇ Military service members can transfer their Chapter 33 benefits to their dependents if they meet the requirements .

Chapter 31 "VR&E" Veterans Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Program

- ◇ Must be evaluated and referred by a Vocational Rehabilitation counselor from a regional veteran service office.
- ◇ Electronic authorization through Tungsten Portal
- ◇ If you qualify for study aid, this pays the university 100% of the tuition costs, among other benefits.
